The following sections of SOW are revised:

- Section 2.2.5 (a) Pipes, ducts, valves, dampers, fittings, wastewater and sewer lines, traps, catch basins, hot water heaters/geyser, toilet fixtures, toilet accessories, plugs, chains, hoses, down-spouts and gutters for clogging and loose joints, restrictions, leaks, and other faulty conditions. This includes all bathrooms, kitchen, water tanks, water tank pressure pump, install ball valve on air vent pipes, baths and kitchen, interior and exterior sewer, and drains lines. Remove hard pipe, install flexible pipe, if any, for gas connection. Prepare and paint gas line with yellow paint (approximate 30-foot length). Check well water pump both deep well and Monoblock, replace if not working (If installed).

The Contractor shall inspect and maintain all fire extinguishers.

The following sections of SOW are added:

- Section 2.2.14 Provision of Fueling
 - a) Contractor shall provide fuel to all locations mentioned in the SOW as and when needed for any equipment which may require fueling.
 - b) Contractor shall submit the invoice based on the prevailing fuel rate in the market plus its transportation cost and profit. (Do not include fuel price in line item#10)
 - c) Fuel shall only be provided upon receipt of approved BPA call/order
- Section 2.2.15 Provision of Water
 - a) Contractor shall provide water to all locations mentioned in the SOW as and when needed.
